### Institut de Biologie Structurale – IBS<sup>2</sup>

The construction of the IBS<sup>2</sup> building provides adequate space for research activities undertaken by structural biologists. The building optimally fills the complex functional organization and offers maximum flexibility in order to enable changes in research requirements to be met. The foyer, a lecture room, administration areas, technical rooms and two laboratories are all located on the ground floor. Flexible laboratory spaces and offices are grouped on the four upper levels, arranged around two large atria. The continuous façade gives the building its special character, comprised of lamella structures that give the rectangular a more varied and dynamic appearance.
